TABC Issues Cease and Desist Letters to Six Unlicensed Businesses Selling Alcohol to Consumers in Tennessee

(NASHVILLE) The Tennessee Alcoholic Beverage Commission (TABC) ordered six unlicensed businesses to cease and desist further shipping operations in the state after successful undercover operations by TABC agents. Investigations by the TABC found that these businesses were illegally shipping alcoholic beverages directly to consumers in the state.

The businesses issued the cease and desist order include:

- Good Company Wines, Inc. aka Invino of Sonoma, CA
- The Wine Salon at Mountain Lakes of Mountain lakes, NJ
- Caskers of New York, NY
- Flaviar of New York, NY
- Sherry's Wine & Spirits of Washington, D.C.
- ReserveBar of Ridgefield, CT

Complaints received from the public initiated the agency's investigations into these businesses. Businesses that illegally sell alcohol without a license could face possible felony criminal charges for violation of the winery direct shipper and tax statutes.
