

# TENNESSEE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE COMMISSION MINUTES THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 27 1:00 p.m.

The February 2020 meeting was held on February 27, 2020 at 1:00 p.m. in Nashville, TN. Chairman Skiles, Commissioner Roberts, and Commissioner Tomita were present. The manufacturer doing business at 900 44th North Ave., Suite 100, Nashville, TN 37209 is requesting approval of a change in ownership. One of the minority shareholders listed above passed away and transferred their interests to the corporation, Speakeasy Spirits, LLC. This less than 1% transfer caused slight changes in ownership for the other seven current shareholders with no one getting more than 0.3% from the transfer. The TABC staff recommends approval of the change in ownership at the manufacturer.

Discussion/Action Taken: Director Thomas summarized the request and recommended approval of the change in ownership. Commissioner Tomita moved approval and the motion was seconded. The motion passed with three ayes.



#### 5. MISCELLANEOUS

- Director's Update
  - **Discussion/Action Taken:** Director Thomas updated the Commission direct shipping investigations, which led to six unlicensed businesses ordered to cease and desist further shipping operations in the state after successful undercover operations by TABC agents. Investigations by the TABC found that these businesses were illegally shipping alcoholic beverages directly to consumers in the state. Complaints received from the public initiated the agency's investigations into these businesses.
- Law Enforcement Update <u>Discussion/Action Taken:</u> CLEO Tubbs updated the Commission on enforcement activity since the last meeting including statistics on the number of inspections conducted, citations issued, fine amounts, minor compliance checks and compliance rate, seizures, and personnel news. Tubbs also discussed a successful operation at Thompson-Boling Arena in Knoxville during a University of Tennessee basketball game with no citations or issues reported. And finally, Tubbs mentioned that three agents were sent to training in San Antonio, Texas for labor trafficking investigations.
- New TABC Agents Sworn In
   <u>Discussion/Action Taken:</u> Deputy Chief Brent Clayton introduced Christopher

   Manning and Bradley Bowen before they were administered the oath by Chairman Skiles. Rebecca Daenzer was not sworn in because of illness.
