


Tennessee Counties Infested with Hemlock Woolly Adelgid









Hemlock Woolly Adelgid infested counties

In Tennessee, 43 counties are known to be infested with HWA. They include **Anderson**, **Bledsoe**, **Blount**, **Bradley**, **Campbell**, **Carter**, **Claiborne**, **Cocke**, **Cumberland**, **Fentress**, **Franklin**, **Grainger**, **Greene**, **Grundy**, **Hamblen**, **Hamilton**, **Hancock**, **Hawkins**, **Jefferson**, **Johnson**, **Knox**, **Loudon**, **Marion**, **McMinn**, **Meigs**, **Monroe**, **Morgan**, **Overton**, **Pickett**, **Polk**, **Putnam**, **Rhea**, **Roane**, **Scott**, **Sequatchie**, **Sevier**, **Sullivan**, **Unicoi**, **Union**, **Van Buren**, **Warren Washington and White**.

Six states with HWA quarantines are Maine, Michigan, New Hampshire, Ohio, Vermont, Wisconsin and Canada. Entry requirements for hemlocks from infested or adjacent areas vary from state to state. A State Phytosanitary Certificate is required.
