



## Lobbyist Indirect Gift Disclosure Form

**INSTRUCTIONS:** This form is for lobbyists to report any indirect gifts that are made to an official in the legislative or executive branch or to his or her family member who received the gift at an in-state event. A lobbyist must disclose if an official in the legislative or executive branch or his or her family member accepts such a gift while attending the event. The lobbyist must have also attended the event and know or have reason to know that the gift has been provided at the suggestion or direction of such lobbyist. This indirect gift disclosure must be made by the lobbyist to the Ethics Commission within seven (7) days following the event under T.C.A. § 3-6-305(c).
