## **Overview**

## Overview

This report provides updated population projections for Tennessee counties and cities, and for the state as a whole, in five-year intervals extending to 2025. The projections are intended to be used as a tool in the planning process, particularly at the local level in support of Public Chapter 1101, commonly referred to as the *Growth Management Law*. Those who make use of these population projections should be aware that the Tennessee Department of Health has recently released population projections for the state and sub-state areas as well. The estimates produced by the Department of Health project a slightly lower rate of statewide population growth than the estimates presented here and are based on some different assumptions about the rate of in-migration of people into local communities and the state.

Unlike the estimates prepared and released in 1998 by the Center for Business and Economic Research, the current estimates were developed using the well-established *cohort-component* technique that is widely used in the field of demography. The cohort-component method, explained in greater detail in the Technical Appendix to this report, builds up population estimates by looking at the components of population change: births, deaths, and migration. Fertility and mortality rates are generally quite stable, so migration becomes a critical component of demographic forecasting. Because the projections developed here extend so far into the future (to the year 2025) and the 1990s were a period of unprecedented population growth, an average migration rate for the past four decades is used in this analysis.

The use of the cohort-component technique has enabled development of more detailed demographic projections for the state and sub-state areas. Specifically the current projections offer detail on the age and gender composition of counties, cities and unincorporated areas of counties. (The Department of Health projections provide age/gender/race detail but only for county units.) Generally estimates such as these are less precise than estimates of aggregate population. Accordingly the detailed demographic estimates must be used with caution. Greatest confidence is placed in demographic projections for Tennessee counties, since the data used to support these estimates are generally deemed to be of relatively high quality. Estimates for sub-county areas are likely to be less precise than their county-level counterparts so additional caution is warranted in their use.

Estimates are presented for counties, cities, and unincorporated areas. The cohort-component model provides county-level figures; population estimates for specific sub-county areas (both cities and unincorporated areas) are extrapolated from the county estimates using actual population data for 2000, 2001, and 2002. It must be recognized that it is impossible to explicitly account for the way the growth management law might cause future population settlement patterns to differ from the past. While an intent of the law is to increase relative city densities, this has not been directly factored in to the estimates.

When projections were made in 1998, heavy reliance was placed generally on data from the 1990 Census, and in particular on city-level estimates through 1997. The 1990 Census figures have been criticized for undercounting the population, although the magnitude of the undercount has not been well documented. (The 1990 undercount is another reason for using a four-decade average migration rate as noted above.) The current projections benefit from the more recent and presumably more accurate 2000 Census; the city-level projections rely heavily on 2000 Census data and estimates for subsequent years. Differences in methodology and better quality data have produced significant differences in the current estimates for some cities and counties vis-à-vis those developed in 1998; estimates of the state-level population have changed little. Again, the Technical Appendix to this report provides additional detail on the methodology and data used to arrive at and verify the projections.

The estimates presented in the body of the report are formatted in a variety of ways to facilitate their use. The first major section of tables provides aggregate projections for (i) counties; (ii) cities arrayed by their

respective county; (iii) cities arrayed alphabetically; (iv) counties by Development District; (v) Tennessee counties within newly-designated metropolitan statistical areas (MSAs) (Tennessee now has 37 counties that are included in 10 different MSAs.), and (vi) demographic information on age-gender composition, alphabetically by county.

**Additional Data**

All of the information presented in this report is posted on the web sites of the Center for Business and Economic Research (<http://cber.bus.utk.edu>), and the Tennessee Advisory Commission on Intergovernmental Relations ([www.state.tn.us/tacir/](http://www.state.tn.us/tacir/)), which funded the research. For those people interested in examining these projections in greater detail, the cohort–component data for individual cities and counties is also available on the TACIR website. In addition, the version of this report posted on these web sites will eventually provide maps (not available in the hard copy of the report) that display unofficial copies of the county-wide growth plans and offer aggregate population projections for 92 of Tennessee’s 95 counties. Three counties, Davidson, Trousdale and Moore, have metropolitan governments and thus are not required to develop growth Plans under PC 1101. The electronic files were graciously provided by Colin McLeod of the State Department of Economic and Community Development’s Office of Local Planning. While these are not official maps, they may still prove useful to those interested in local planning.

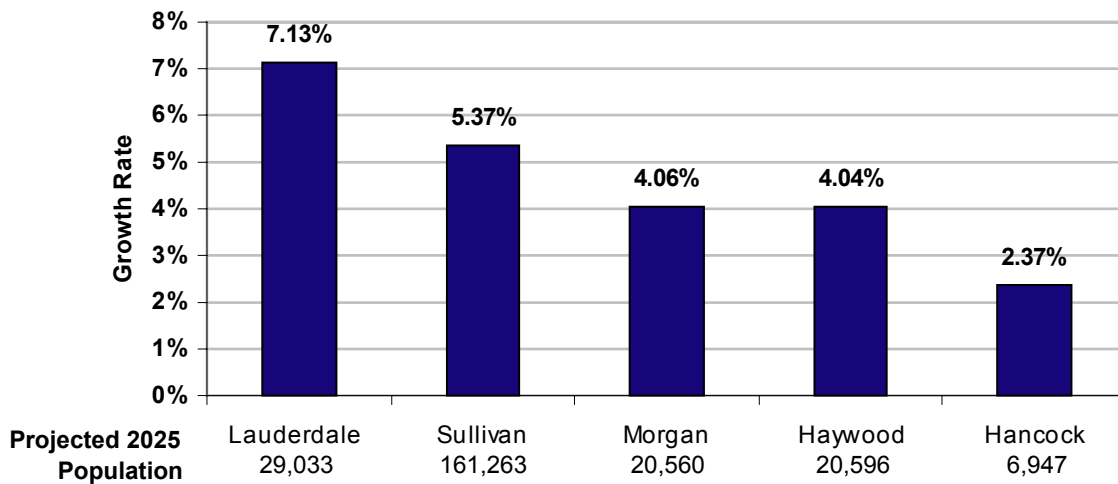
**A Word of Caution**

Users of this data should be aware that population projections such as these rely on a number of assumptions about the continuation of past trends into the future. When using population projections such as these, people are encouraged to use them as a guide illustrating a general possible scenario of future growth patterns. Although these projections are based on a mathematical model using sound scientific principles, ultimately, the overall accuracy of these projections will depend on the extent to which future events unfold in a manner that mirrors these past observations. Different projections using different assumptions will inevitably yield different results. In addition, there may be people with specific knowledge or understanding of events and factors that may affect their local communities that could result in a more complete understanding of the growth dynamic affecting their community. **Thus, we caution users not to construe these figures as predicting a specific or inevitable future course of events.** Instead, the numbers contained within this report should be read as a likely course of future population change based on a continuation of past trends. Population projections such as these are simply one of a number of tools that planners and local community leaders should consider when envisioning the future for their communities.

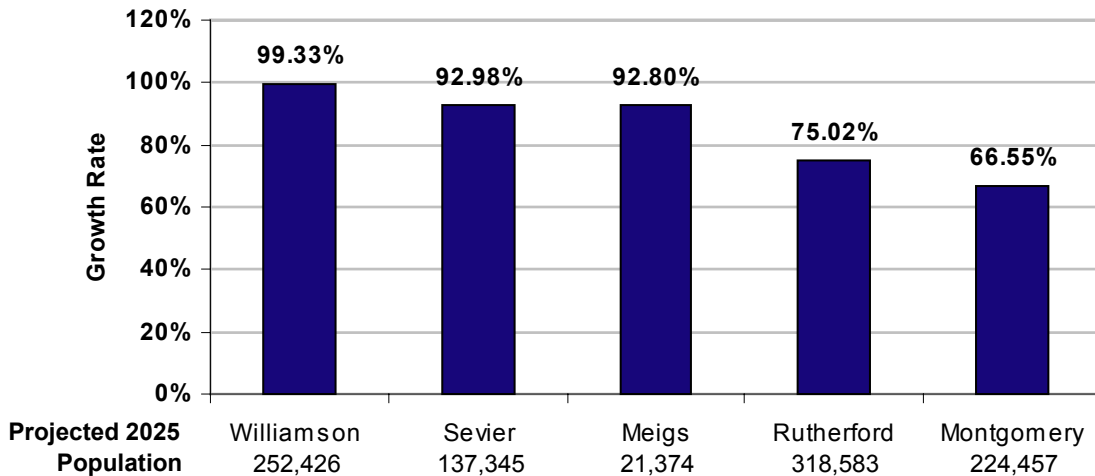

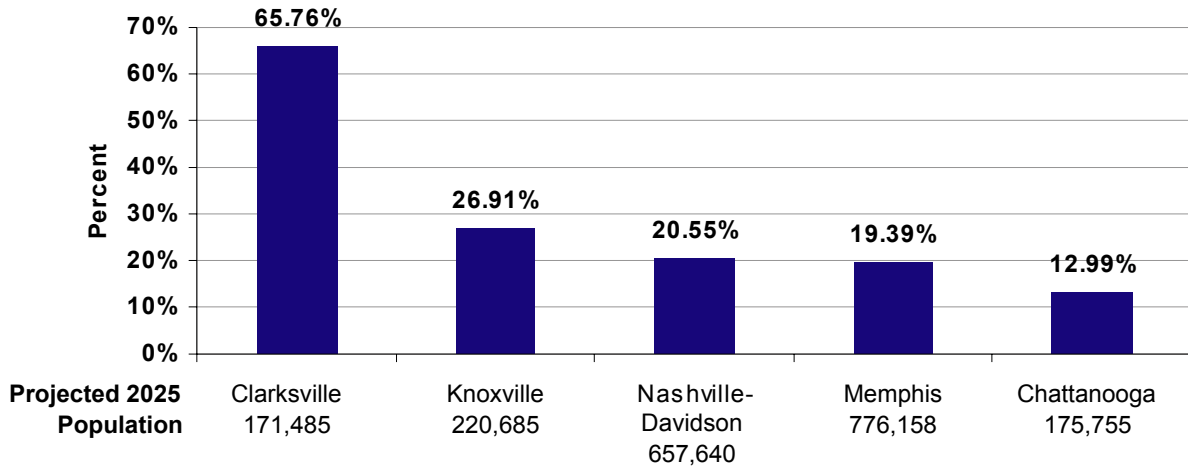
**Figure 4: Five Counties with the Highest Projected Population Growth Rate, 2005 to 2025**

As shown in Figure 3, the five counties with the slowest projected total population growth are Hancock (2.37 percent), Haywood (4.04 percent), Morgan (4.06 percent), Sullivan (5.37 percent), and Lauderdale (7.13 percent). With the exception of Sullivan, all of these are relatively small, rural counties. Figure 4 shows the five counties with the highest projected growth in population through 2025, Williamson, Sevier, Meigs, Rutherford, and Montgomery. Williamson, Rutherford and Montgomery counties are in middle Tennessee where much of the state’s recent growth has been concentrated. Sevier County, adjacent to the Great Smoky Mountains National Park, will continue its strong rate of growth buoyed in part by rapid growth in the tourism trade.

**Figure 3: Five Counties with the Lowest Projected Population Growth Rate, 2005 to 2025**

Of the five largest cities in Tennessee (i.e., those with population greater than 150,000) the three with the largest projected percentage growth rates are Clarksville, Knoxville, and Nashville (as shown in Figure 5). For mid-sized cities, those with populations between 25,000 and 75,000, the cities with the largest projected growth rates are Franklin (98.78 percent), Smyrna (96.49 percent), Murfreesboro (81.48 percent), Hendersonville (59.19 percent), and Collierville (40.02 percent). For smaller cities with populations between 10,000 and 25,000, the highest projected growth rates are projected for Brentwood (144.51 percent), Mount Juliet (143.37 percent), Sevierville (135.51 percent), and LaVergne (105.77 percent). For small cities with less than 10,000 people, the highest projected growth rates are expected in Whiteville (324.80 percent), Spring Hill (192.63 percent), Gatlinburg (123.76 percent), Atoka (120.36 percent), and Fairview (107.16 percent).

with the Largest Projected Population Growth, 2005 to 2025**

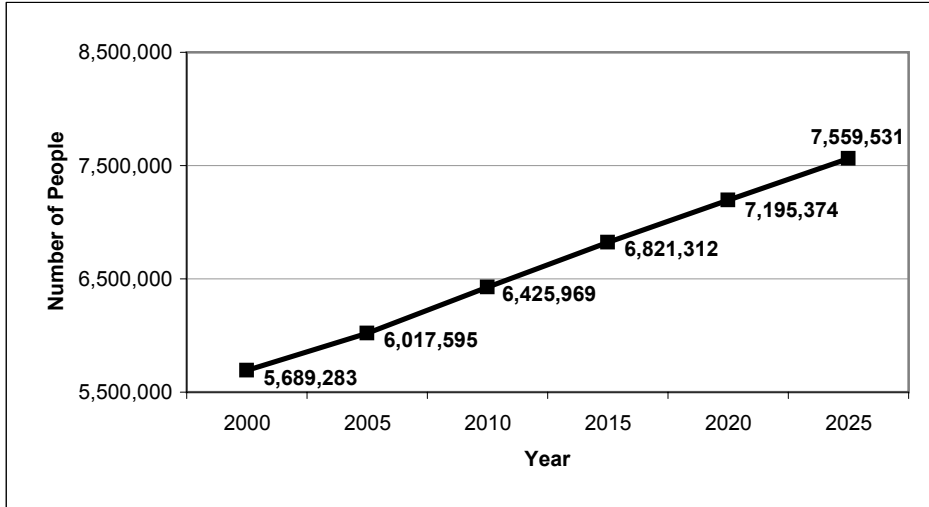


While growth *rates* give an indication of how quickly or slowly an area is growing, it is also important to consider the total number of people in a county or city, as a high growth rate does not necessarily result in a large population. In terms of total number of people, the three counties with the largest population growth throughout the 2000 to 2025 period are Shelby (200,813), Rutherford (136,560), and Williamson (125,788). The three cities with the largest projected populations are Memphis (126,058), Nashville-Davidson (112,116), and Clarksville (68,030). The three counties with the smallest projected population growth are Lake (755), Van Buren (434), and Hancock (161).

## Technical Appendix

### State, County, and Sub-county Population Projections for the State of Tennessee

#### State Level Projections

The projections of the state population for each period result from summing the county populations obtained through the cohort-component method, which is outlined below.

#### County Level Projections

##### 1. Technique

A cohort-component demographic model is used to project population for the Tennessee counties. Using the 2000 Census counts, the population is carried forward at five-year intervals to the year 2025. The population is categorized by gender and five-year age groups. The cohort-component model allows one to make assumptions about how each age and gender cohort will migrate and survive between each five-year interval. This model also allows one to make assumptions about fertility rates so that children projected to be born in future periods can be added in at each projection interval. The component aspect of this model examines those activities that are the “components” of population growth: births, deaths, and migration.

##### Mortality

The first step in the projection procedure is to calculate the number of people in each age group that are alive in the base year (2000) and survive through the first projection period (2005). This is accomplished by multiplying the base year population by the age-specific five-year survival rates. In this study, the age-specific survival rates have been calculated from the *United States Life Tables*, 2000 edition.

##### Migration

In these projections, a net migration model at the county level is used. Due to the known undercount in Census 1990, and in order to more accurately capture the long-term migration patterns of the state that are extrapolated to 2025, net migration rates are calculated for the previous four decades: 1960-1970, 1970-1980, 1980-1990, 1990-2000. These rates are then averaged to obtain the average net migration rate for each age and gender cohort at the county level. Because the rates that are calculated are for a ten-year period, the rates must be adjusted to a five-year rate in order to match the projection period.

## Fertility

In order to gain the most accuracy in the projections, age-specific fertility rates are calculated for each county using the average of the fertility rates for 1999, 2000, and 2001. There are three steps that need to be computed in order to arrive at the number of births. In the first step, the at-risk female population (broken down by age) is multiplied by the calculated age-specific fertility rates in order to project the total number of births. (At-risk females are simply the females of childbearing age.) The second step is to allocate births as males and females using historical proportions. The final step is to survive the births forward; this becomes the youngest age group in the next projection period. These calculations are performed for each county separately.

## Institutional Effects

Special populations include those people living at colleges and universities, nursing homes, military bases, and prisons. Because these populations do not exhibit the same demographic characteristics as the general population, they must be treated differently in the projections. For the purposes of this study the assumption is made that these populations do not change in size or age distribution throughout the projection period and therefore, the population counts of these groups are held constant.

## Final Projections

The final projections combine the results of each of the three previous steps: mortality, migration, and fertility. The process is then repeated for the next projection period and continues until the results for the final period are obtained. The county population projections are the foundation for the sub-county projections, which are detailed in a separate section below.

## 2. Data

Using the cohort-component method at the county-level requires a large amount of data. The level of specificity of the data affects the accuracy of the projections and the most detailed data are used whenever possible. The population at the county level for the base year (2000) is available from the United States Census Bureau in *Summary File 1 (SF-1)*. This file contains population counts separated into the desired cohorts: 5-year age groups for males and females. The special population counts are also obtained from the Census Bureau in the file *Group Quarters Population by Race and Hispanic Origin: 2000 (PHC-T-7)*.

To calculate the five-year age-gender-specific survival rates, an abridged life table available from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) is used (*United States Life Tables, 2000*).

The calculations of the county net migration rates require the most data. The age-gender-specific Census population counts at both the county level and for the United States are needed for the following years: 1960, 1970, 1980, and 1990, in addition to the 2000 counts already used. Calculation of the net migration rates involves projecting the number of people that are expected to survive to the next time period and in order



accomplish this, 10-year survival rates are calculated for each decade using the life tables for the United States available from the CDC. An exception is the survival rate for the decade of the 1960s, which is not available, so the rate from 1966 is used instead. Use of historical survival rates increases the accuracy of the projections since survival rates have exhibited an increase in the United States over the last four decades.

Age-specific fertility rates at the county level are obtained from the Tennessee Department of Health for the years 1999, 2000, and 2001. An average of the three years is used in order to smooth any peaks that may have occurred in any given year. The fertility rates are applied to all females between the ages 10-44 that are not part of the institutional population.

## Sub-county Level Projections

### 1. Technique

Due to the immense data requirements of the cohort-component method at the sub-county level and the lack of availability of the necessary data, a different method is employed for these projections. An exponential extrapolation method is used to allocate the county population projections into their respective sub-county areas. Possible extrapolation methods include the linear method, the geometric method, and the exponential method. The linear extrapolation method assumes that the population is increasing (decreasing) by the same number of people in each future period as the average annual increase in the base period. The geometric extrapolation method assumes that the population will increase (decrease) at the same annual percentage rate during the projection period as during the base period with the growth rates compounding at discrete time intervals (most often, annually.) The exponential extrapolation method is very similar to the geometric method except that the growth rate is continuously compounded. Because population growth is assumed to occur continuously rather than discretely, the exponential extrapolation method was deemed superior to the other two methods.

For the sub-county projections, three years of data are used, 2000, 2001, and 2002. The intercensal population estimates provided by the Census Bureau for 1991-1999 are based on the 1990 Census, which is known to have a significant undercount, therefore, those estimates were deemed unreliable for the use of projections. The sub-county area population as a share of the previously calculated county population for each projection period is obtained using the exponential extrapolation method. Census 2000 provides the age-gender population at the sub-county level. These data are then used to calculate the sub-county age-gender shares. These share are applied to the sub-county population totals to allocate the population into the appropriate age-gender cohort. An important implication of this procedure is that the age-gender mix of the sub-county population is assumed to remain constant over the entire projection period.

### 2. Data

The Census Bureau provides estimates of the sub-county populations for 2001 and 2002 and are based on Census 2000. These estimates are used to calculate the sub-county population shares for each projection period.

Checks

The population projections are checked against the *Projections of the Total Population of the States: 1995-2025, Series B*, provided by the Census Bureau as well as those projections completed by the firm Woods & Poole Economics. The results for the total population for the state of Tennessee are found in the table below. It should be noted that the projections provided by the Census Bureau are based on the 1990 Census.

The difference between population projections in this report and those provided by Woods & Poole is found to be, on average one half of one percent. The differences between the numbers for 2000 are due to the following: the Census Bureau is an estimate based on the Census numbers for 1990. Woods & Poole use data from the United States Department of Commerce that are based on Census population estimates.
