These efforts may include strengthening their agency's Wellness Council, improving Wellness Council communications and/or trying different strategies to engage and inspire their workforce.
Cammunicative of the grass	Communicator of the Year The Communicator of the Year award recognizes a Wellness Council that excels at reaching all their employees and keeping them in-the-know about workplace wellness events, activities and resources.
Engagement disease.	Engagement Award The Engagement award recognizes the Wellness Council that "moves the masses" – providing their employees with activities they want to join so they keep coming back for more.
